An iconic New York City neighborhood running from 14th to 23rd Streets, Stuyvesant Town has been a staple of NYC for over 70 years - with thousands of New Yorkers continuing to call the 80 acres home.

Encompassing IIO buildings and II,250 apartments, the complex was developed by the Metropolitan Life Insurance Company and was based on earlier developments: Parkchester in The Bronx and Riverton Square in Harlem.

Former Metropolitan Life president Frederick Ecker said StuyTown would make it possible for generations of New Yorkers "to live in a park - to live in the country in the heart of New York."

In October 2006, MetLife sold StuyTown to Tishman Speyer. The new ownership implemented significant capital projects on the property. Tishman Speyer relinquished control of the property in 2010. CW Capital remained the owner from 2010 to 2015 when they sold the property.

Today, the property is controlled by Blackstone/Ivanhoe Cambridge, which uses StuyTown Property Services as StuyTown's property manager. StuyTown is now home to over 30,000 residents.
