











LOCATION AND TAX MAP

MARKET OVERVIEW

NEWARK | NEW JERSEY is the most populous city in the state of New Jersey. It is a major air, shipping, and rail hub and is part of the New York Metropolitan area.

Located at the mouth of the Passaic River, the city's waterfront is an integral part of the Port of New York and New Jersey. Port Newark–Elizabeth is the primary container shipping terminal of the busiest seaport on the U.S. East Coast. Local cultural venues include the New Jersey Performing Arts Center, Newark Symphony Hall, the Prudential Center and The Newark Museum of Art.

Newark contains neighborhoods ranging in character from bustling urban districts to quiet suburban enclaves. Newark's Branch Brook Park is the oldest county park in the United States and is home to the nation's largest collection of cherry blossom trees, numbering over 5,000.








